

# Wisconsin Education Recruitment Fair Candidate Policies

The Wisconsin Education Recruitment Fair (WERF) is hosted by the University of Wisconsin-Madison and is sponsored in collaboration with UW-Madison, and 32 of Wisconsin's public and private universities. The Wisconsin Education Recruitment Fair provides an opportunity for professional educators from the participating education colleges and universities in Wisconsin and beyond to meet with school districts from throughout the U.S.

WERF's purpose is to connect K-12 school system employers, recognized by the state's department of education, with K-12 candidates.

WERF is open to ALL certified teacher and professional services candidates.

The cost to attend WERF is \$20.00 and \$5.00 for individuals who can be verified by their respective Wisconsin sponsoring institution.

To qualify for the reduced price, candidates must be verified by their institution's representative by the designated date on the WERF registration website.\*\*

**Registrations after the online closing date and any registrations at the door will be a fee of \$20.00 for any candidate. Verification for registrants will occur through February 18<sup>th</sup>.**

**\*\*Definition of Verified Candidate:**

A verified candidate is an individual who earned a teacher education degree from one of the listed Wisconsin schools on the registration page and registers prior to the closing registration date listed. Each candidate who requests to be verified is verified by their alma mater's career services.
