*B. Elective Courses:* (chosen in consultation with advisor)

There are no specific courses required of candidates for the M.S. with specialization in Exercise Psychology. In accordance with Graduate School policy, a minimum of 30 credits is required for the M.S. degree. Electives courses to meet the degree requirements are chosen in consultation with the advisor.
